3. It is mandatory to join the allotted seat Online Stray Vacancy Round 5. Hence candidates should fill only those Preference/choices for which they are ready to take admission, if allotted.
4. Candidates are advised to verify and ascertain the fee structure from the college website or Fees Regulating Authority website before filling the preference/choice.
